RESERVING LODGING THROUGH DCFF

- DCFF reserves a limited number of motel rooms & campsites for participants. Space is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- If you can stay for only one (1) or two (2) nights, we recommend that you either select the camping option or that make your own arrangements for lodging (see below). DCFF may have a limited number of motel openings for 1 or 2 nights. Lodging booked directly through DCFF includes a weekend pass to dance workshops and parties during your stay.
- You may reserve accommodations for **stays extending before and/or after the Festival**. Special pricing available for non-dancing kids, partners, spouses, etc. Call about these special rates and note all special requests on your Registration Form.
- Motel Rooms: Participants may book motel rooms for 3 or more nights (limited openings for 1 or 2 nights). Rooms include a private bathroom, color TV, small fridge, A/C, Internet. Some rollaway beds/cots available for extra guests for a fee.
- Camping Space reserved at Aqualand Campground, a wooded, park-like setting just outside of Sister Bay & Ephraim. Amenities include heated swimming pool, modern rest rooms, hot showers and electricity. Participants may camp for 1 or more nights.
