- Who uses and for what
 - Country clubs, hotels, dance studios, banquet halls, schools, dance groups, weddings, anniversaries, parties
 - Irish step-dancing, tap dancing, ballroom dancing, swing dancing, tango, etc.
 - Manufacturer: Some clients have had floors 20+ years with little or no damage
 - Vendor: Have been renting SnapLock floors to the public for 10+ years with minimal or no replacements
 - Most damage comes from inexperienced people during installation/de-installation
 - Very few instances of damage from clients uses of portable dance floors
- Easy installation/de-installation
 - No tools required (occasionally a rubber mallet), no special knowledge or expertise required

- Extremely stable (no shifting or slipping) when using more than 4 panels
 - Floors take a real beating (Irish dance, Tap dance)
 - For smaller configurations, use non-slip vinyl sheeting or even a Marley mat underneath the panels
- Low incidence of panel replacement
- Each panel has four locks per edge so a panel is still serviceable with loss of/damage to some of the locks
 - More incidents of loss (misplacement) of edges than of panels
 - Individual panels and edges can be replaced
- Best storage method in wheeled carts
- 12-year manufacturer's warranty
- Suggested flooring styles
 - Oak, Teak, Maple, Dark Maple, Smoked Oak

“Here is a video on how to assemble and disassemble our dance floor. I’m a woman and I’m around 5’2” tall. I could set a 21x21 dance by myself in under an hour. If you have two men setting up a 27x48, they should be able to set up in easily 3 hours or less. Whomever is setting up and tearing down the dance floor, needs to watch this video so they don’t damage the locking system on our dance floor.”
